





In a few short years the interest in Gay Rodeo has led to the foundation of nine State Rodeo Associations. January 1985 saw the formation of the International Gay Rodeo Assoc., which is the governing and regulating body for the state and regional organizations. I.G.R.A.'s main goals are the encouragement and growth of Gay Rodeo as a sport, through uniformly operated rodeos, standardized set of rules and regulations by which the contestants compete. The I.G.R.A. Board and Trustees are members of the individual state rodeo associations belonging to I.G.R.A..

It finally happened after many months of talk and discussion. There are two divisions in the International Gay Rodeo Association as of November 1987.

Contestants may cross division lines and compete in rodeos out side their respective division. They can still earn prize money, ribbons, buckles, and the all-around cowboy or all-around cowgirl title for that particular rodeo.

The top five qualifiers in individual events from each division, and the top ten qualifiers in camp events from each division will be invited to compete in the International Finals Rodeo. Also, the top five qualifiers from each division in team roping will be invited to the International Finals Rodeo. All contestants will go to the Finals with 0 points, and points awarded at the Finals will be the same as at a Divisional Rodeo.
