Gay rodeo this weekend

Between 2,000 and 3,000 people are in Wichita this weekend to participate in or attend events of the International Gay Rodeo, being held in the West Bank stage area.

Promoters of the event did not issue press permits for rodeo events and requested no coverage by local media.

Well, doesn't that just about cover it? Hardly, but that's all the coverage we wanted from the Wichita Eagle.

IGRA's Finals Rodeo 1991, has come and gone. Another new Rodeo year is about to start in Dallas, Texas. But before it does, let's look back at this year's Finals.

Overall results? It worked! Everything went smoothly and successfully, which is a near miracle considering the obstacles that Kansas, and the GPRR group had to deal with beginning just two months ago. At that time you'll remember, the Wichita press ran an article heralding the appearance of Gay Rodeo in their City. Nice article, but it tipped off the local homophobes, who stormed our scheduled Arena and caused them to back out of their contract with us. Approval for the second site was delayed by their City Council for awhile (probably fears over more trouble in conjunction with their ongoing battle with the Anti-Abortion wackos). And then apparently someone associated with the original Arena, who was going to continue to help us out at the new site,

also backed out, leaving the Rodeo organizers in the lurch just weeks before "showtime".

Yet despite these, and other ongoing hassles, they pulled it off. Everybody seemed to be having a good time (we know the AGRA crowd did) and the GPRR Organization is to be congratulated for it!


