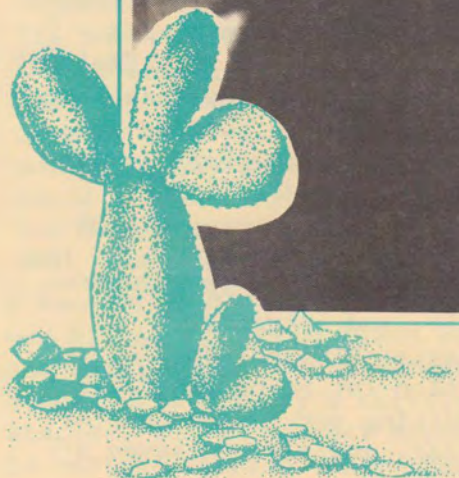
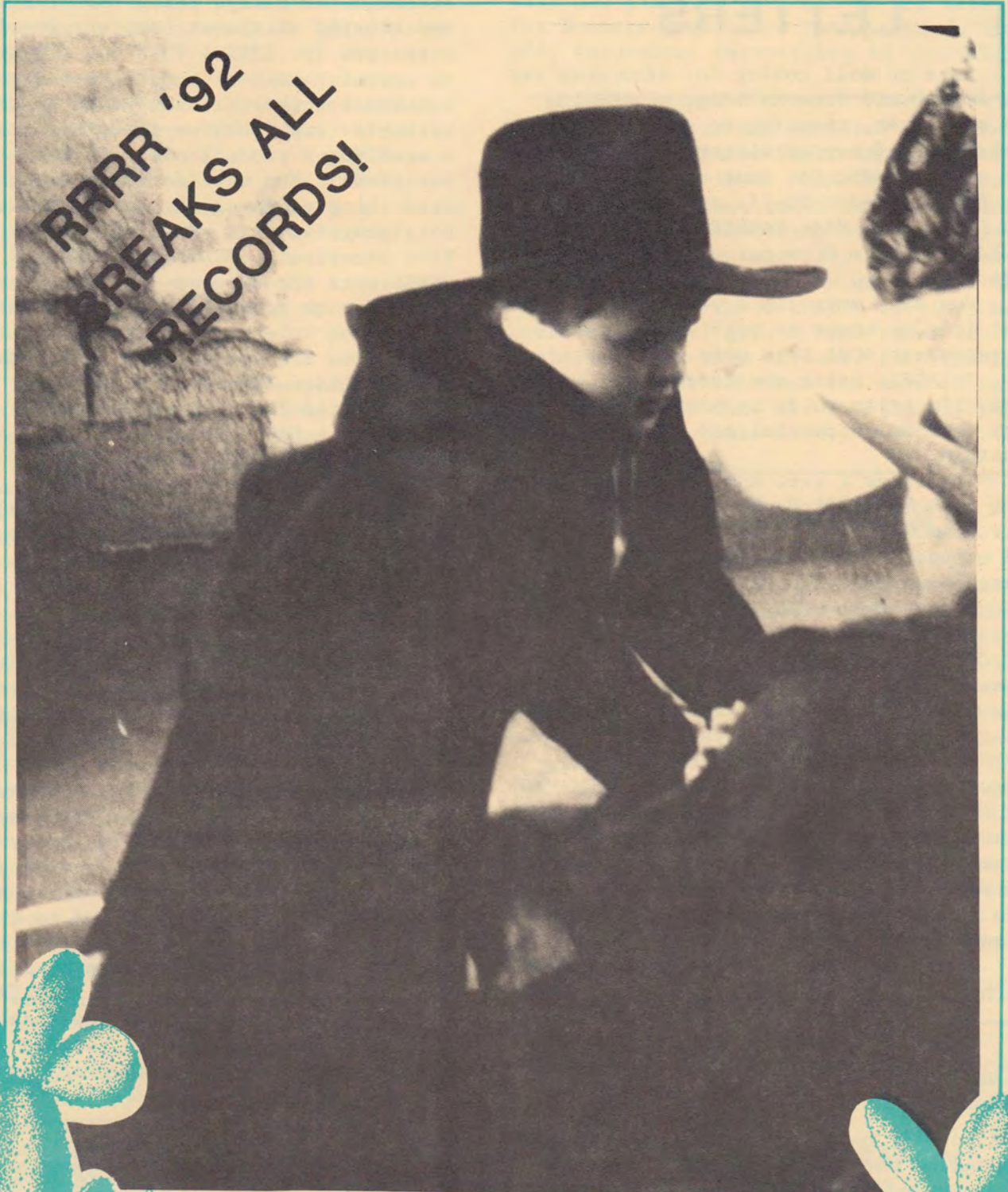

Lots going on at RRRR '92 on the Royalty front, and we were backstage to see it all...

CONSUELA RODRIGUEZ (JOE RUBIO) completed her year as Miss AGRA '91 the same way she conducted her entire reign, as a class act. Her farewell medley was the climax. Gorgeous ballad, followed by a slide show of memories and thank-yous, and finally, an uptempo number that kept the crowd cheering. Consuela somehow managed to fit that in, while also helping the Contestants, and being featured in the opening production number both Friday and Saturday nights. Special thanks, by the way, for that superb opening number go to Mr. DAVID ANAYA for his choreography and costumes, as well as local illusionists DEVINA, KYRA STARR, and MARQUESSA, who along with our Miss Contestants, did a lot of work to stage that.

Mr IGRA JIM CARTER, and 1st Runner-up KEN BOGE. Ms IGRA RC CUELLAR and 1st Runner-up PAULA HAND. And Miss IGRA ROXIE HEART, and 1st Runner-up KADDIE BLACKWELL. With this kind of IGRA talent and experience, we think our '92 Royalty slate should have a good chance at this year's Finals. Thanks to all of them for coming, and being a pleasure to work with.

Highlight of the Royalty Contest may have been backstage during the announcing of the Miss winners. When Victoria was announced as 1st Runner-up, Jacquleene was busy congratulating her on a job well done.
