I know that our community looks forward to this event every year and expect the Road Runner Regional Rodeo (RRRR) 2003 to be bigger and better than ever. I am still getting my feet wet as Trustee and am beginning to get regular communication from IGRA. Here is some updates from IGRA:

Bicardi Silver Sponsorship: we are expecting a contract any day that will provide each rodeo with \$1,000 cash and 2 special buckles to be given out at each rodeo for the Bicardi Silver All-Around Camp Event Male & Female. The process of determining the winners is being worked on. I think this is a great way to our entry level and expert camp cowboys and cowgirls.

Instinct Magazine did pick up their first right of refusal and has offered a new "twist" to their contract. They will allow associations/chapters to sell instinct magazine ALL YEAR at a below the regular sub price and get a commission, a very good commission! This is a great opportunity to raise money throughout the year. I will discuss this opportunity further with the board.

I expect that there may be some complex Rodeo Rules questions come up at the RRRR related to gender issues that were approved at convention in 2002. We struggled with these gender issues then and will continue to struggle with them throughout this Rodeo year, however I believe we will work it out and be better off for it. I will keep the rodeo committee and membership posted on any developments.

That's all the news from IGRA at this point. Let's look forward to a safe and prosperous new year and a successful and fun Rodeo.

RODEO TRANSPORTATION...

Great News! Transportation, as mentioned in the last general membership meeting, has been secured for the 2003 Road Runner Regional Rodeo with Gray Line Tours. The buses will be the same as last year - charter-style buses. Below is a listing of prelimary pickup times for the charter bus service.

First pickup from Charlie's at 4:00pm and the last bus will pick up from Charlie's at 3:00am

Saturday, January 18th: First pickup from Charlie's at 6:15am and the last bus will pick up from Charlie's at 3:00am

Sunday, January 19th: First pickup from Charlie's at 6:15am and the last bus will pick up from Charlie's at 1:00am

Note: The times listed above are only for the first pickup and the last pickup of the day. Other locations, such as hotel stops will be published at a later date.

We have formed a great relationship with Gray Line, not only for rodeo purposes, but for sharing our mutual contacts with various organizations. What does this do for A.G.R.A.? It opens up a wealth of opportunities to make future contacts in the community that support the kind of charitable work that A.G.R.A. is so well known for. Additionally, it enables us to create a more concrete bond with Gray Line and create a mutually beneficial relationship. This tour takes takes passengers to the Grand Canyon with a brief stop in Flagstaff. Cost is \$99.00 per person.


