Trustee's Report

I attended the IGRA Board & Trustees' Meetings in Denver, Colorado on July 8. Some of the actions taken in the meetings include:

- Road Runner Regional Rodeo – February 17-19, 2012 was approved
- A Texas Tradition Rodeo in Fort Worth – March 2-4, 2012 was approved
- Hot Rodeo 2012 in Palm Springs – May 4-6, 2012 was approved
- Sunshine Stampede's (Ft Lauderdale) rodeo application was not approved because the association had not submitted the 2011 rodeo settlement sheet, and it is long past due.
- Ed LaBrash, GWGRA member, was certified as a Rodeo Scorekeeper.
- Clint Coil, ARGRA member, was approved as a Rodeo Student Judge.
- IGRA Appreciation Awards will now be accepted through October 1, 2011.

I would like to remind everyone that the Zia Regional Rodeo will be August 12-14, 2011, and it will be in Santa Fe, New Mexico rather than in Albuquerque. The Windy City Rodeo will be the very next weekend, August 19-21 in Chicago.


