Hello Members,

Well, we have another IGRA Annual Convention "under our belts". The 29th IGRA Annual Convention was held at the Hilton Hotel Mission Valley in San Diego November 15-17. AGRA had a full delegation consisting of Ron Trusley, Michael Weidmann, Jai Crystal, Dan Iversen, John King, and Marcos Sandavol as Delegates and Kevin McSweeny, Todd Wyckoff, Michael Chavez, Doug Holmes, and Edgar Garcia as Alternates. I believe AGRA was represented in every committee meeting on Friday.

The convention ran quite smoothly, and there was no major debate. Surprisingly, there are not even a lot of Bylaws/Standing Rules or Rodeo Rules changes. Most of the rodeo rules changes deal specifically with individual events. I would like to give you a quick and brief summary of convention actions.

Three associations did not renew their membership in IGRA. The associations are: CCGRA-Central Canada Gay Rodeo Association, HSRA-High Sierra Rodeo Association, and SSRA-Sooner State Rodeo Association.

A quick summary of changes that affect the association include:

The rodeo sanction fee was increased from \$600.00 to \$700.00, but the seat tax will no longer be required. And, by the way, in 2013 AGRA was the only association that paid an additional seat tax for tickets sold over 1,000. The \$25.00 per event contestant entry fees will be divided with \$17.00 to contestant day money, \$4.00 to the host association, \$2.00 to be held in escrow by IGRA for finals day money, and \$2.00 to the IGRA General Operating account.

In camp events, steers cannot have bobbed or partial tails.

Riding steers must be a minimum of 800 pounds

The tractor must be removed from the active performance area area during contestant runs.

Associations are no longer required to include a copy of the "IGRA Health & Safety Newsletter (aka Horse Sense) in the contestant and staff packets.

Rodeo stock must be comparable to stock used in a "senior division" rodeo.



No smoking is allowed within the arena, working chutes area, or secretarial area while the rodeo is in progress.

Rodeo requirements or rule changes made at annual convention affecting an association whose rodeo is less than 90 days may ask for a variance in the board of trustees' meeting following close of convention.

James Jenkins from CGRA was elected as IGRA Vice President, and Bruce Gros from CGRA was elected as IGRA Secretary.

Inducted into the IGRA Hall of Fame were Lloyd (Mitch) Gill, Jeannine Tuttle, Linda Frazier, and Lee Kittleson.


An IGRA-sanctioned rodeo, offering all 14 approved events, will be held in conjunction with Gay Games 9 August 9-6, 2014 in Cleveland & Akron, Ohio. Depending on the number of contestant entries, the rodeo will be a 2-day event, a 4-day event, or a 6-day event.

Dan Nagel from TGRA will be the IGRA Finals Committee Chair for 2014, and Clark Monk from ARGRA will be the Rodeo Director. The 2014 finals rodeo will once again be in Fort Worth, Texas.

The 30th IGRA Annual Convention will be in Denver, Colorado November 13-16, 2014, and the 2015 convention will be at the Sirata Beach Resort in St Petersburg, Florida November 12-15, 2015.

Eight of the AGRA Delegates and Alternate Delegates attended the 2nd Annual Paladin Awards Dinner and Ceremony on Saturday evening. We gave a "brief" presentation on "Pride in the Saddle – Arizona". The presentation provided a very short history of AGRA, recognized our two remaining founding members – John King & Dan Iversen, and comments about the monthlong activities at the Burton Barr Phoenix Public Library in March 2013. The library received the Paladin Award; however, no one from the library was able to attend. Later in the year, the award will be presented to the library; and it is my understanding that the City Mayor and other city officials will be in attendance.

In the post-convention Trustees' Meeting, Ray Ostmann-GWGRA was elected as Trustees' Chairperson. Guy Puglisi-NGRA was elected as Division I Vice Chairperson; Janie Van Santen-ARGRA was elected as Division II Vice Chairperson; and Steve Schultz-ILGRA was



elected as Division IV Vice Chairperson

Only 14 local rodeos are on the 2014 schedule along with the rodeo at Gay Games 9 and the IGRA Finals Rodeo.

Finally, I want to thank everyone who helped in any way with the November 24 bake sale. Walt Hutter began with preparations a few weeks ago and was up at 4:30 am on Saturday continuing with the baking and preparations. On Saturday, Patrick Roe, Michael Weidmann, Jai Crystal, Greg Begay, and Mikey spent several hours helping with the preparations, decorating, etc. Thanks to those who helped carry in everything from the cars and helped with the sales throughout the evening. And, a special thanks to everyone who sold the turkey raffle tickets. Amazing that all of the baked goods were sold out in just about two (2) hours! THANK YOU TO EVERYONE!!!
