I had written quite a lot of information for the December 2014 Branding Iron; unfortunately, it was not published. In this report I will simply summarize a few things from the 2014 IGRA Annual Convention.

Jerry Hubbard, Cindy McCormick, David Pizutti, Brian Rogers, and Ron Trusley were inducted into the IGRA Hall of Fame. Of these five people, only Brian and Ron are still actively involved. Thirteen rodeos were approved for 2015 with the first being the Arizona Gay Rodeo February 13-15. I have attached the schedule, but please note that 2016 and 2017 dates are only tentative and not yet approved.

Elections were held for IGRA President and Treasurer for 2-year terms beginning January 1, 2015. Bruce Gros from CGRA was elected as president and David Hill from CGRA was re-elected as treasurer. Bruce was holding the position of secretary, but immediately upon election as president, he submitted his resignation as secretary. It was then up to the IGRA Board of Directors to appoint someone to complete the secretary term ending December 31, 2015. In a meeting following convention on Sunday, the board appointed Pierre Cadieux from ARGRA to complete the secretary term.

Actions taken in the January 16 board meeting:

Ryan Reed from MGRA was appointed as the IGRA Public Relations Director.

The 2015 IGRA Finals Rodeo will be at the South Pointe Arena in Las Vegas, Nevada.

The board will explore the possibility of holding the 2016 finals rodeo at South Pointe.

The 2016 IGRA University will be at the Doubletree Suites by Hilton Tucson Airport in Tucson,

Arizona January 15-17.

IGRA insurance for 2015 was approved. Association premiums increased only slightly. Our premium is \$485.74 for rodeo and the association.

The board approved three charities recommended by IGRA Royalty. The charities are:

Trevor Project, Ronald McDonald Charities, and Stand for the Silent.

We were informed that Anheuser-Busch will not be renewing their sponsorship with IGRA.

Nominations for the IGRA Hall of Fame must be received by March 1, 2015. The nomination form is on the IGRA website.

The AGRA Annual Corporation Meeting & Banquet will be Friday – February 27, 2015 at T-Bone Steakhouse. More information will be forthcoming very soon.

I have had the pleasure over the past several years to serve as your fundraising director. I have worked with some amazing boards and many awesome Royalty Teams who have made my job easy.


