I was also able to attend the NGRA Royalty Contest over Christmas weekend and they now have a new Mr. and Ms. that will be going on to compete at Finals. We already have a couple shows for our upcoming royalty here in December, as of this writing, the 5th and the 26th, shows will be at the Rainbow Cactus.

#### Trustee's Report

AGRA was well represented with 6 delegates and 1 alternate delegate at the 31st IGRA Annual Convention in St Petersburg, Florida. Each person attended committee meetings on Friday and participated in the business sessions on Saturday and Sunday. AGRA should be very proud of your representatives at convention.

Elections were held for IGRA Vice President and Secretary for 2-year terms beginning January 1, 2016. Jason Bernard-TGRA was elected as Vice President and Ron Trusley-AGRA was elected as Secretary.

Although, the business sessions seemed to run quite late, there were not a lot of major changes to IGRA Bylaws/Standing Rules and Rodeo Rules. Some changes were rather minor. Following are changes I think are significant to mention:

- Voting by ballot will not be allowed in IGRA Directors and Trustees meetings.
- The Women's Outreach Committee was changed to Women of Gay Rodeo Committee.
- The president will now appoint an Animal Issues Committee Chairperson and request each Member Association to provide a representative to the committee.
- The Rodeo Officials Committee (ROC) will be a standing committee.
- In the IGRA Royalty competition, there will now be 7 judges, instead of 5.
- Contestants will choose to compete in either the horsemanship or entertainment category, and the choice will be indicated on the application at submission. Once the application is submitted, the category cannot be changed.
- In rodeo events rerides must be completed during that go of that event and contestant should be moved to the end of the running order for that gender's event.

#### Trustee's Report

On line registrations for a rodeo must be completed and paid for by 10:00 pm mountain time.

- For roping events, at the start of the event, the finish flag judge will be mounted on horseback and positioned in the arena on the header box side.
- In breakaway roping, if the rope accidentally makes a half hitch around the saddle horn, the rider may undally the half hitch but cannot assist in the rope breaking away from the horn.
- In chute dogging, the start judge will drop a flag and simultaneously blow a whistle when the chute gate begins to open.
- In chute dogging, losing contact with the steer such that no part of the contestant is touching any part of the steer will result in disqualification.
- In chute dogging, a dog fall (dog fall defined as head in an opposite direction of one or more legs) will be a disqualification.
- Chute dogging will have a 60 second time limit. Arena buzzer, horn, or whistle will sound to indicate the end of the 60 second time limit.

The 2016 World Gay Rodeo Finals will be October 21-23 at South Point in Las Vegas. No bids were presented to host the 2016 IGRA Annual Convention, so the Board of Directors will choose a location.

I want to thank Walt Hutter for the many hours he dedicated to preparing for the annual Christmas bake sale and for baking for numerous hours. Also, thanks to Michael Butts for spending over 8 hours helping on Saturday. Thanks to everyone who sold or helped sell raffle tickets for the turkey giveaways. Money raised from the raffle ticket sales was \$296.00, and \$492.00 was raised from the bake sale.

#### Trustee's Report

Now it is time to start planning for the annual Christmas bake sale that will be Sunday – December 20.
