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
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### Howdy!


### Fundraising Garage Sale Sunday, May 23, 9 am to 3 pm

# **Bud Light Canadian Rockies International Rodeo**Let Us Entertain You!

The Bud Light Canadian Rockies International Rodeo July 1-4 promises to be full of fun, entertainment and Wild West action. New this year is the Bud Light Stage on the Midway of the rodeo grounds. Beginning Thursday July 1<sup>st</sup> every evening between 5pm and 7pm the Bud Light Stage will showcase singers, performers, and karaoke.

Thursday night will kick off the weekend with the hysterically funny and talented celebrity impersonator Joanna. Joanna is called the Gal with a Gazillion Voices and sings in his own voice over 30 celebrity impressions from Patsy Cline, Celine Dion, Liza Minnelli and even Johnny Cash. All the song parodies are hilarious and original. A dance will follow Joanna and later Thursday night will be the July 1<sup>st</sup> Canada Day fireworks which will be visible from the Rodeo Grounds.

If you have ever wanted to learn how all those cowboys and cowgirls do those events, come try them out! Our very first rodeo school is geared for the very beginner that has never competed before. Come learn all about:

- Calf Roping on Foot (Roping 101)
- Steer Decorating
- Chute Dogging
- Steer Riding

This is a great way to learn – it's a stress free environment, you will be instructed by experienced cowboys and cowgirls, and you can practice your event more than once (time permitting). It's also a great refresher for those that have entered before to get warmed up, practice with the stock, and maybe learn a new technique or two! ALL STUDENTS must come **between** 9:00AM and 9:30AM to registration. You will check in, and sign a liability waiver.

**Orientation** 9:30AM – 10:00AM

ALL STUDENTS - Meet at the chutes at 9:30AM SHARP! We will be watching the IGRA Health and safety video, answering questions and getting you oriented. Once Orientation is complete, you are free to come learn your event at the following times:

Steer Decorating
Chute Dogging
Steer Riding

Each event is \$25.00 CDN per person. The online form uses PayPal and all major credit cards are accepted. It's a great deal – like we have said before, there is expert instruction, it's relaxed and unhurried, and you can try your event as many times as time permits!

ARGRA will have some equipment for you to use (size permitting)! Check the ARGRA website for more information as to what to bring as a minimum. You need very little to get going!

With your newly learned rodeo skills, you as a rookie cowboy/cowgirl can still register and enter the Bud Light Canadian Rockies International Rodeo (CRIR) Friday night! This is your chance – become a real rodeo competitor! (Keep in mind that enrolling in the Rodeo School is separate from registering to compete in the Bud Light CRIR.)

### **About Team Shirts:**

- Shirts can have any markings you like: Team name, a sponsor name, nick name, city, and graphics use your imagination! Just keep in mind it's a family show.
- Can be the same both days or can have two different ones for Saturday and Sunday
- It can be as simple as, for example, purchasing a long sleeved shirt from a department store and using ironons all the way to purchasing a western shirt and having it embroidered!!
- If you want to go all out, be sure to check out our western store; Prairie Saddlery in Strathmore.

### **Dress Code during Grand Entry**

Grand Entry is your time to shine! You will be announced and paraded though the arena for all to see! As part of the rodeo tradition, you will wear your team shirt and are expected to also have long pants, a western hat, and boots. Check out the 2010 IGRA Rule Book for exact rules.

### How Teams will be evaluated:

Number of people on the team (1 point per person) Number of events entered (1 point per event) Team Shirt (1 to 20 points – subjective to judges call)

BONUS POINTS - Team Spirit / Sportsmanship (0 to 20 points – subjective to judge's call).

Team with the most points at the end of the weekend, evaluated by our judges, wins!
