
From the President

Results from Cowtown Rodgo

Eight CGRA members traveled to Fort Worth in early March for the Cowtown Rodeo.

John Beck went to check on Rusty, so he says. He and Rusty placed 6th in pole bending on the second day and 5th in flag race that same day. The only thing he placed in on Saturday was a 6th place in wild drag race along with RC Cuellar. He and RC also placed 3rd in wild drag race the second day, which moved them into 4th place for the weekend.

RC Cuellar had a good weekend in chute dogging. She placed 4th the first day and 1st the second day which placed her in 2nd place for the buckle only to be topped by Des Gronwald. In horse events, she had a tough time against the very strong Texas cowgirls. However she did have a 5th place in pole bending the first day and a 6th place the second day to keep her in 6th place for the weekend.

Char Duran covered her steer in steer riding the 2nd day with a score of 85 and a 1st place. Since no one covered both days, she captured the buckle with her 85 score. In flag race she took an 8th place the 1st day.

Des Gronwald had a great weekend chute dogging. She captured 1st place on Saturday and 4th place on Sunday. She had the same placements as RC but in reverse order. However her times were slightly better so she pulled ahead of RC by 6 10th's of a second to take the buckle. On Saturday, she placed 6th in pole bending and on Sunday, she placed 5th in flag race. She caught her calf the first day to take a 2nd place but did not catch the second day. She and Robert Thrutell placed 4th in wild drag race on Saturday but did not place on Sunday.

Patrick Kellogg entered in steer riding, chute dogging and calf roping. He did dog on Sunday with a time of 7.70 but did not place.

Robert Thurtell placed 2nd in steer riding the first day but did not cover the second day. He dogged on Saturday for 8th place and 6th place on Sunday, which placed him 5th for the weekend. The competition in horse events was very strong; he got a time in all three but did not place in any. As mentioned before, he and Des got a 4th place in wild drag race the first day and a 4th place in goat dressing that same day.

Bryan Williams, Mr. CGRA, got an 8th place in wild drag race the second day but failed to place in any of the horse events. However, as he informed me, he was not last in any horse event so that was an accomplishment.

Our last contestant, **Rick Witt**, attempted to calf rope but was unsuccessful either day. He did chute dog with a time both days but failed to place either day.

Congratulations to all members who competed and especially to the two buckle winners, **Char Duran** in steer riding and **Des Gronwald** in chute dogging.

The next rodeo on the circuit is the Sunshine Stampede in Fort Lauderdale, April 4 through April 6. Good luck to all members traveling there.
