Here's something interested I found while looking at the upcoming horse expo March 13-14. rocymountainhorseexpo.com.com for all "horsey" folks. It's a new license plate called "Support the Horse". It is a new license plate that is new as of January 1st, 2009 in conjunction with the Colorado Horse Development Authority, www.chda.org.

The cost is \$30 to CHDA and \$50 to the Highway Users Tax Fund (payable to the DMV when you pick up your plates). These are a one time only fee. Although their website says the plates are available for horse trailers, they are not as of yet, I've checked with both the DMV and CHDA. They are working on getting that changed. So check out the CHDA website and read the article and how to order your certificate before going to the DMV to get your plates.


