# LONG AWAITED HOUSTON RODEO IS HERE!!

Beginning November 9th, people from all over the country will be Texans for a weekend. The much publicized Houston rodeo will finally be a reality. The finest cowboys and cowgirls alike will be roping, riding and running for the money and the prestigious belt buckles. After a hard day in the arena, the nights will be filled with plenty of socializing; giving everyone an opportunity to meet the contestants and spectators.

Contestant registration will be from 6-10 p.m. on Friday night in the Hyatt Regency Downtown ballroom. Friday starts the rodeo celebrations with the TGRA Kick-Off Dance, beginning at 8 p.m., also in the Hyatt Regency Downtown. At 11 p.m. Mr. Ms. and Miss TGRA will be announced.

Saturday the box office opens at 10 a.m., with the Grand Parade beginning at 12 p.m. Saturday night will be a chance for everyone to experience some of the great night-life found only in Houston. Local people as well as some visitors will be around to direct anyone to the popular clubs and restaurants in the area. Don't forget the DSRA cocktail party at the BRB, Saturday night!

The final day of the rodeo will be Sunday. The box office again opens at 10 a.m., with Grand Parade at 12 p.m. You will not want to miss the Rodeo Awards Dance this night in the Imperial Ballroom of the Hyatt Regency, beginning at 8 p.m.

Advance ticket prices for the rodeos are \$12.50 through November 8th, and \$15.00 at the door. Box seats are \$20.00 through November 8th, and \$25.00 at the door. Visa, Mastercard and Discover cards are accepted. Tickets can be purchased at any Ticketron location nationwide.

The host hotel is the Hyatt Regency Downtown. Room rates are \$61 and \$71 per night for 1 to 4 persons. You must mention TGRA for these special room rates. For reservations, call (713) 654-1234.

## UNIT 1 RODEO AWAITS IGRA SANCTION

In October, the general membership approved a motion that allows DSRA and NSGRA to send an important letter to IGRA. This letter will request the sanctioning of the Unit 1 and Unit 2 rodeos, which are tentatively scheduled for April and May, 1991.

With this sanction, a date for the Unit rodeos will be reserved on the international calendar. It will also allow both DSRA and NSGRA to seek corporate sponsorship as well as support from other rodeo associations.

The Unit 1 rodeo for DSRA would include 7 events, primarily the speed racing events and camp events (wild drag race, etc..). The NSGRA Unit 2 rodeo would also host 7 events, including the rough livestock events (bronc riding, etc.), as well as the camp events. All IGRA rules apply, and IGRA points would be awarded.

Even with the IGRA sanction, there will be no penalty for DSRA or NSGRA in the event that the rodeos are cancelled; as long as the cancellation is made before March 1st.


