
Sherry and I will be hosting a fundraiser at the clubhouse on Saturday May 11th, see the article

FERAL CATS


DSRA will be hosting a fundraiser for the FERAL CAT PROGRAM on May 11th, 2002 at the clubhouse. Admission will be \$5.00 which is tax deductible and the event will start at 8:00 pm.

The FERAL CAT PROGRAM was started primarily to address a countrywide problem of feral cats. The primary purpose of feral cat management is to STOP the reproduction. Feral cats are those who have been abandoned by their owners to fend for themselves and wooded areas of the county. These animals have continued to produce off-spring which seldom have contact with people (they come from their hiding places at night) and are considered "wild". They form colonies around apartment complexes, behind restaurants, and live as best they can, usually eating from dumpsters. The FERAL CAT PROGRAM was established to trap, neuter/spay, and release these cats, usually back to the place they were captured. If kittens can be caught at an early age, these can often be tamed and placed for adoption. When possible, there is a caretaker who has been or will continue to feed and monitor the colony. There are sick, starving, and pregnant Mama kitties out there now (spring is mating season) that we need to trap and get care for.

There will be a raffle for a number of prizes, such as: tanning packages, restaurant gift certificates, etc. Karaoke available for the gifted and talented, food

for the hungry, and a cash bar for the thirsty. Please come and join in the fun and bring everyone you know for this worthy cause!


