Don't forget Membership Renewal is due July 1st. Have a good summer til later.



I'd like to wish you all a fantastic Gay pride week and the most spectacular of Independence days.




ROYALTY REPORT

Happy Pride!!!!!!!!

I would like to take this opportunity to wish everyone the best of Pride celebrations as we observe Gay Pride Month and Gay Pride Week. Sherry, Rita, Cody, and Elizabeth all wish you much joy and happiness as we take this month to look back at where we come from and where we are heading as a gay community. Although their have been many man strides for gay rights over the years, I am especially reminded of "Stonewall". For all you who might not be familiar with it here's some background: In 1969, "Stonewall" took on an entirely new meaning. On Friday, June 27, late in the evening, New York City police made a planned raid on The Stonewall Inn. What began simply for the police department

as a routine "fag-bar" raid quickly escalated into five inconsecutive nights and early morning hours disturbances during which gays, lesbians, and transgender decided literally to fight back. On the first night, employees began being arrested. Some customers were told to leave. Others were detained. But the raid turned ugly around 2 a.m. Saturday morning when angry gay patrons, several transgender, and others started velling "GAY POWER!" throwing stones, coins, and bottles. There are many versions of what happened next. When ultimately the cops barricaded themselves inside on one of the nights, the place was attacked from outside by

as many as 300 people, maybe 400. The police, trapped inside, called for reinforcements. Not all onlookers were pleased. and some threw bottles at the gays. When police reinforcements arrived. some of the rioters dispersed for a while but regrouped. For the next several evenings, and after the media reported eye-catching, escalating incident, they and hundreds of others returned. The word got around fast. The last week of June 1969 became known as the time of the Stonewall Rebellion. which inspired the start of Gay Pride Week.


