- (1) Artwork must be submitted in camera-ready form.
- (2) Submission must be original artwork of the contestant.
- (3) Poster designs must be "rodeo" or "country-western" in nature.
- (4) If artwork is signed by the author, his/her signature will be included in all media formats used by **DSRA**, unless requested is made by author tomit his/her signature.
- (5) Entry must have a contact name and phone number attached.
- (6) Entry must be at least 8 ½ by 11 inches in dimension.
- (7) Submission must be suitable for general public viewing.
- (8) Colored artwork must retain its detail if converted to black and white format.
- (9) Artwork must be suitable for enlargement or reduction, as needed to fit a variety of formats such as poster, flyer or tri-fold brochure.
- (A \$250.00 prize will be awarded to the winner of the contest. The winning artwork will become the property of **DSRA**, and no other remunerations will be awarded.) Submissions may be either mailed to P.O. Box 56503, Little Rock, AR 72215 or emailed to Pitapup@iwon.com
