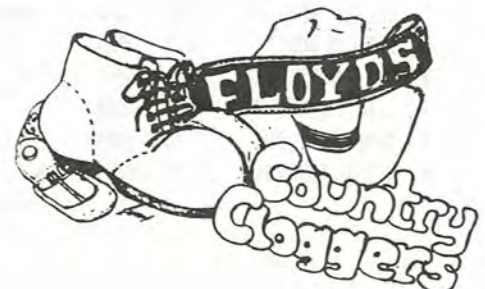
Proud, Strong, United "yep! you betcha!" That is what this group is all about and you can witness that when you see them on or off the stage.

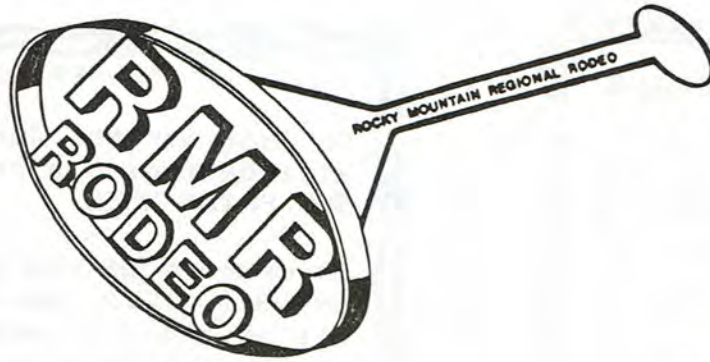
