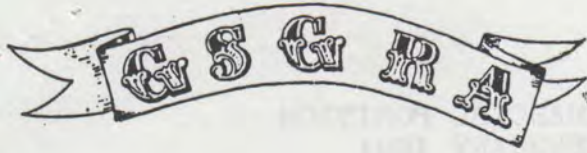

STAMPEDE ANYONE?

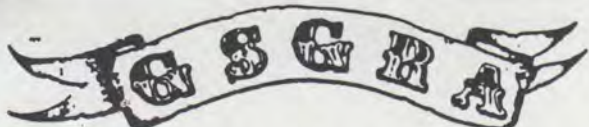

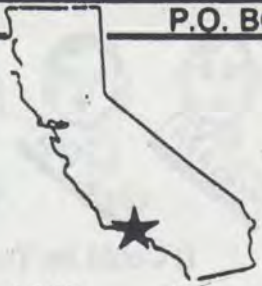
