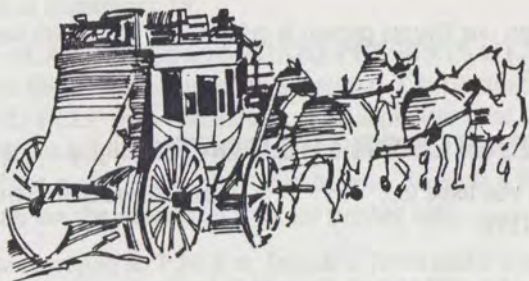
## Up & Coming Events
