Rodeo fans in the Central Valley and the Palm Springs areas, this is for you.




our functions. Even our meetings have a fun tone to them.

LOS ANGELES RODEO INFORMATION

Charities and Grand Marshal Announced

At the December meeting, the chapter voted to have L.A. Shanti, The Minority AIDS Project, and the Gilda Radner Ovarian Cancer Center as the beneficiaries of the upcoming rodeo. This is the first year that Los Angeles has been able to put the charitable donation amounts into the budget before the rodeo. This means that these three worthy groups will be receiving the donation amounts whether or not the L.A. 


