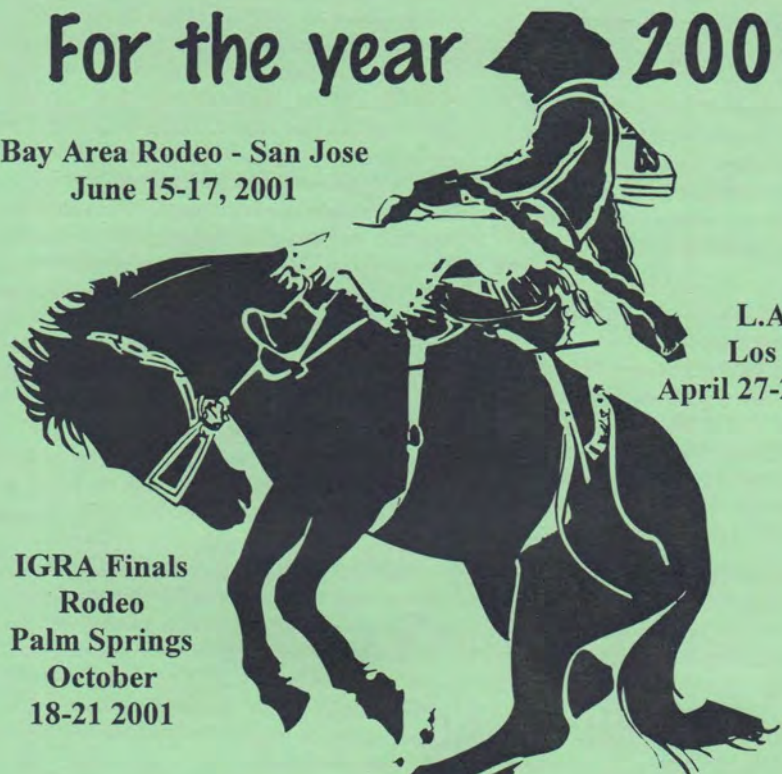

# IGRA Trustee's Report

Folks, a number of important items have come up at the IGRA level in recent weeks. Our IGRA Board meeting at Finals happened a little late to make the November Chute, so here's a summary from my report to our State Board in November.

We spent a good deal of time at the GSGRA State Board meeting discussing the two IGRA beer-sponsorship proposals, from Coors and our current sponsor, Bud Light. If we boil it down to nothing but numbers, the Coors contract is clearly stronger:

- Total value over two years: Bud \$200,000; Coors \$299,000
- Total value over four years: Bud \$435,000; Coors \$637,000
- Amount each rodeo gets over two years: Bud \$9,750; Coors \$11,500, plus \$1,000 each year for advertising
- Amount each rodeo gets over four years: Bud \$21,500; Coors \$23,500, plus \$1,000 each year for advertising

Both contracts are for two years with options to extend. The biggest difference in the contracts is that Coors' proposal includes a sizeable amount each year for various IGRA expenses, like marketing, insurance and the annual IGRA University.

However, as we know, there is concern in areas of our community as to how some local markets might react to a Coors sponsorship. (Remember, this is not a question of how we feel about the Coors boycott or whether it should or shouldn't continue; the issue is entirely how will our local markets respond to our rodeos being sponsored by Coors. And, for our rodeos to be IGRA-sanctioned, each must be sponsored by the IGRA beer sponsor.)

After thorough discussion at the state meeting, an advisory vote was taken to give me a sense of how our state officers and chapter representatives felt. The vote proved what we'd thought all along: The issue is clearly geographic (the Southern California coastal chapters have concerns; the others are comfortable with a Coors sponsorship), and in those affected areas, there is great division and uncertainty about the potential effect of a Coors sponsorship.

The IGRA board will be voting on the proposals in the next few weeks, and my guess is that the Coors proposal will be approved -- based solely on the strength of the dollar figures. In that case, I recommended to the chapters that they prepare action plans on how they'll respond to the potential for criticism in the form of letters to the local gay rags, comments during chapter meetings or public events, or protesters outside a rodeo. We don't know that ANY of these things will happen, but it would be in our best interest to be ready just in case. A lot of good ideas were also discussed on how we might educate our own members and chapters on how to respond to criticism of Coors or the Coors sponsorship. And because California is such a critical market, there is strong sentiment that Coors will be especially eager to work with us to help resolve any issues that might arise.

When the IGRA vote takes place, you can be sure I'll let you know the outcome asap. (About Bud Light: Our existing contract gives Bud Light the right to match any other offer, but Bud was unable to come up with the same amount of money as Coors. Bud Light has been a terrific sponsor over the last two years; I especially appreciate that they came to our rescue two years when Miller unexpectedly ended its IGRA sponsorship. I know we all extend our heartfelt thanks to Anheuser-Busch and to James Ramey, A-B's California-based "alternate lifestyles" marketing manager, for their generous support, help and friendship over the last two years.)

Also in the next few weeks, the IGRA Board will vote on renewing our sponsorship agreement with Instinct Magazine. The IGRA Board had several concerns about how Instinct and IGRA were working together (or weren't), but those items have been worked out and I'm confident we will OK this contract for 2001.

Some other items of interest: -- All of GSGRA is gearing up for 2001, with four big rodeos, plus IGRA Convention and IGRA Finals. For convention (July 26-29 in Long Beach), we'll again have the chapters take on various roles -- running registration, selling dance tickets, staffing the office, serving as "runners"; start to think about what you'd like to do, and we'll start assigning duties during the March GSGRA board meeting. For finals, the Greater Palm Springs Chapter is working extra hard to get things ready; keep your ears open for how you can help. (Continued on Page 7)

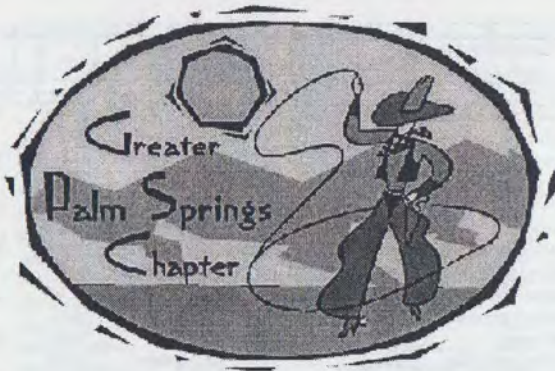
