#### From The Rodeo Director

Well, in case you have not heard, a final site selection has been made for Finals 2001 Rodeo in Palm Springs. The site is the former sports complex project at the intersections of Crossley and Ramon Roads. The site is approximately fifteen acres, complete with city services; a palm tree lined entrance to the facility, parking for about 1200 automobiles, and, is fully fenced and secure. The site is four miles from the host hotel.

Al Wright, assistant Rodeo Director, is fully confident that this is the correct facility, both in terms of location and logistics. While the final design of the rodeo facility is not final, we have designated a separate; secure area for the Horse trailers including a separate entry with a secure checkpoint. It is important to stress that although the site has ample parking, city ordinances will not allow overnight camping on the facility, so be sure and make your hotel reservations.

Speaking of the hotel, there is a rumor that the Palm Springs Marquis is closing down. Well, actually it is not a rumor; it is a fact that like a lot of businesses in Palm Springs the Marquis will close down for two months this summer. This is a scheduled closing, with the primary purpose being contributing to the energy conservation efforts now in place through out the State. Other major hotels are closing floors and or entire wings during this period of low use as well.



#### GSGRA

#### Convention Report

New officers, IGRA delegates and a decision on the definition of GSGRA 's territory were the main topics at the May 12-13 GSGRA Convention (a.k.a. "Annual Meeting of Members") in San Diego. All four of the GSGRA chapters were well-represented at the meeting, which was productive and a lot of fun. too.

Of great interest was a request by the former Capital Crossroads chapter, which has said it wishes to become a separate IGRA member association. IGRA rules allow only one IGRA association in any given territory; since GSGRA's defined territory is the State of California, GSGRA's approval would be needed for the Capital Crossroads group to apply for membership in IGRA.

At the start of the Convention, a letter was received from the Capital Crossroads group asking GSGRA to begin talks on defining what areas of our state GSGRA would agree to give up to the Capital Crossroads group. After a thorough discussion of the potential pros and cons of such a move, the Convention concluded it could not agree to the request and reiterated that GSGRA's defined territory is the State of California, inclusive.

Otherwise, the primary issue on the agenda were elections. With Certificates of Appreciation and applause, the convention expressed its thanks to the 2000-01 officers who chose not to seek re-election:
Administrative Vice President Sammy Van Galder, Vice President of Rodeo Operations Nancy Novak and Secretary Ken Valdez. The newly elected officers:

- -- President, David Medzerian.
- -- Administrative Vice President, Mitch Gill.
- -- VP of Rodeo Operations, Thom Brennan.
- -- Secretary, Joseph Berry.
- -- Treasurer, Bill Chapman.

Roger Bergmann will continue on the Executive Board, as his position of Counselor is for life.

A new Trustee to IGRA was also selected: Al Wright will begin his three-year

term of office when David Medzerian's current term as Trustee expires Oct. 31.

The group also selected this year's delegation to the IGRA convention July 26-29 in Long Beach. GSGRA rules provide that the president and the trustee are automatic delegates; because David will hold both jobs when the convention occurs, the convention selected trustee-elect Al Wright to serve as a delegate. The remaining four delegates and the categories in which they were elected:

- -- Michael DeYonker, bylaws.
- -- Lorry King, royalty/dance.
- -- Bob Pulliam, rodeo production.
- -- Drew Oberbeck, contestants/rodeo rules.

Elected as alternates, who will fill in as needed throughout the four-day convention, are Sy Iverson, Joseph Berry, Jabby Lowe, Michele Chagnon and Steve Creber, with John Carrillo and Tony Nicholson as backups in case one of the alternates unexpectedly cannot attend.

Remember that all GSGRA members are welcome to attend convention; just because you are not a delegate or alternate doesn't mean you can't attend committee meetings and the convention session and do your part to contribute to IGRA -- plus, it's a lot of fun and a great learning experience. The convention registration form is in this issue of The Chute.

Finally, the schedule of GSGRA meetings was set for the next year:

- -- July 21 in Palm Springs
- Nov. 17 in San Diego (including GSGRA Royalty Competition)
- -- Feb. 16, 2002, in Los Angeles (possibly including buckout or play on Sunday)
  May 11-12, 2002, in the Bay Area (convention, including GSGRA Dance Competition).


#### Add Article XIX: CHAPTER NAME, LOGO, ACRONYM
