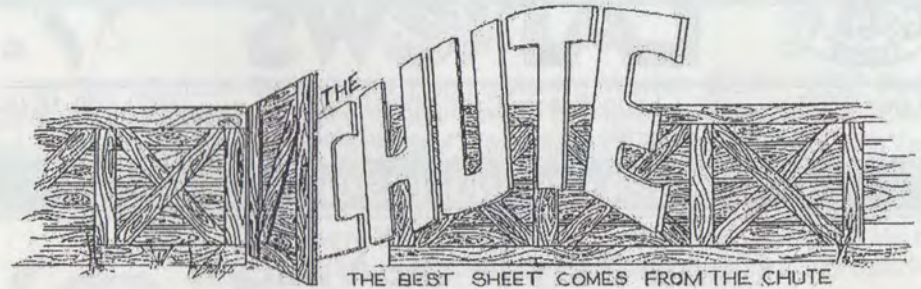

Tickets, Tickets, Tickets...

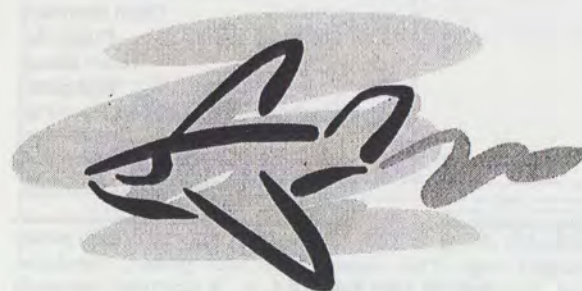

A WORD FROM THE EDITOR

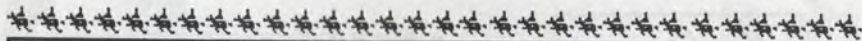
