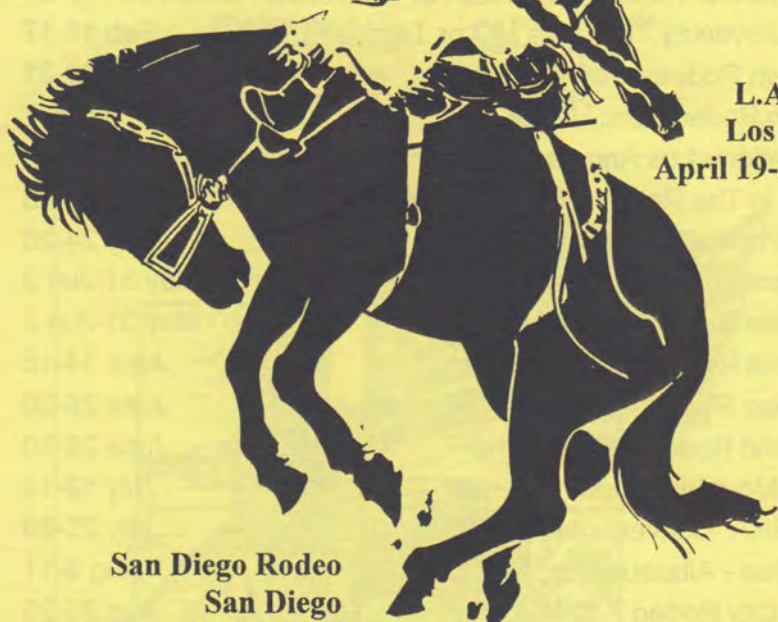

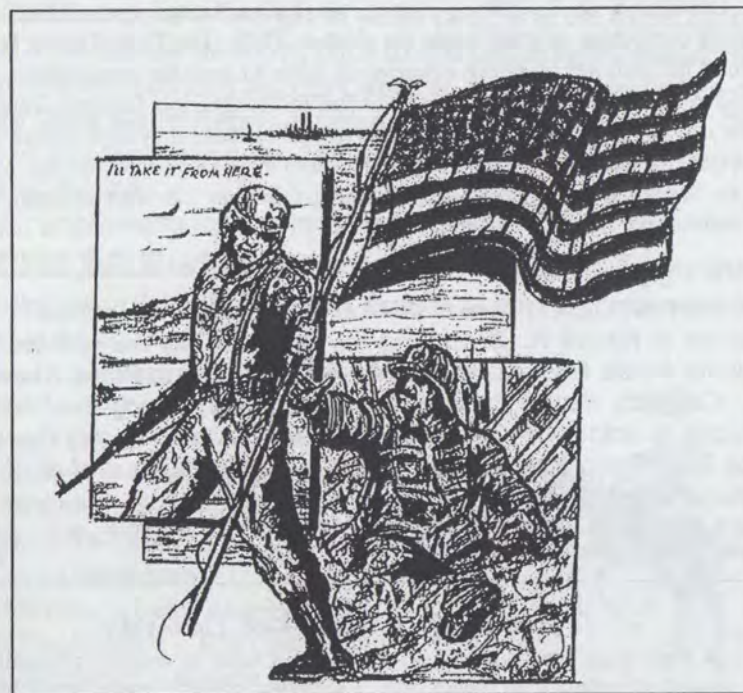

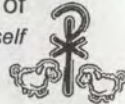


Thank you Beer Bunnies!!

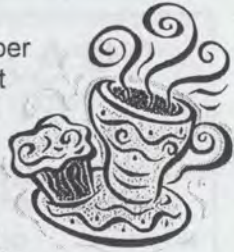
Beautiful Blanket Bounty...

PRESIDENT AND TRUSTEE REPORT

What a terrific Finals Rodeo! After more than a year of planning (and only one or two mild crises!), the IGRA Finals Rodeo in Palm Springs was a great success. I am so proud of the Greater Palm Springs Chapter, and I know you join me in congratulating Barry Hamm, Doug Belk, Al Wright, Lorry King, John Johnson, Lee Self, Chuck Marx, Darrin Land, Judy Galloway, J.G. Avila and the rest of the rodeo team for their hard work -- and the terrific results. The groundwork is certainly set for the Palm Springs Rodeo to return to the IGRA schedule in November 2002.

In 2001, GSGRA has done the impossible: We've hosted three terrific IGRA circuit rodeos (Bay Area, San Diego and this year's largest IGRA rodeo, Los Angeles), a successful IGRA Convention (Long Beach) and a wonderful Finals Rodeo (Palm Springs). No IGRA association has ever done this, and we couldn't have pulled it off without the efforts of each of our great chapters and our fabulous members. Give yourselves a hand!

On to trustee business. IGRA has new national sponsor starting January 1, 2002: DeKuyper's Pucker, from Jim Beam. Pucker will be the "official cordial of IGRA" for the 2002 calendar year.

Under the one-year contract, approved at the IGRA Board's Oct. 19 meeting, Pucker will give IGRA \$20,000 in cash and 350 cases of "product." Rodeos that have had previous Pucker sponsorships should get the cash they had previously; the remaining money will be divided among the other rodeos (it looks like Los Angeles and San Diego will have their previous Pucker sponsorship amount matched, and the Bay Area and Palm Springs rodeos would each get about \$500). As for the cases of Pucker, each IGRA association

gets about a dozen and a half cases. We're researching to see if California law allows us to accept this donation; if not, I'll have to drink it all out of state -- or GSGRA can allocate our cases to another IGRA association.

Additionally, the Pucker logo is now one that you have to use on everything that promotes your rodeo; and you can't have any other "cordial" as a rodeo sponsor.

The board was also prepared to consider a sponsorship from the "180" energy drink, but the proposal was withdrawn at the last minute. Anheuser-Busch has withdrawn all promotional and marketing funding from the product.

Also at the IGRA Board meeting, the schedule of trustees' meetings was set for 2002 -- and this year it includes a stop in California. The trustees will meet:
-- Jan. 18 at the Phoenix rodeo.
-- April 19 at the L.A. rodeo.
-- July 26 at the IGRA Convention in Cleveland.
-- Oct. 11 at IGRA Finals Rodeo in Wichita.

Finally, although I continue as GSGRA president, the October IGRA board meeting was my last as your GSGRA trustee. As you probably know, having served as trustee since 1997 I chose not to run for another term. Al Wright starts a three-year term as GSGRA trustee to IGRA on Nov. 1, 2001.

During my five years as your trustee, I've represented GSGRA at 19 IGRA board meetings, five IGRA conventions and 48 IGRA rodeos, and GSGRA has hosted two IGRA conventions, 17 regular rodeos and one finals rodeo (no wonder my hair turned white). It has been grueling but also rewarding, and it has been a privilege and honor to represent you and our great organization at the IGRA level. Good luck to Al, and thanks to all of you for your help, support and encouragement over these five years.

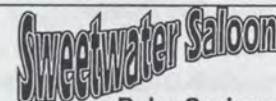

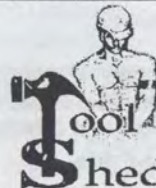

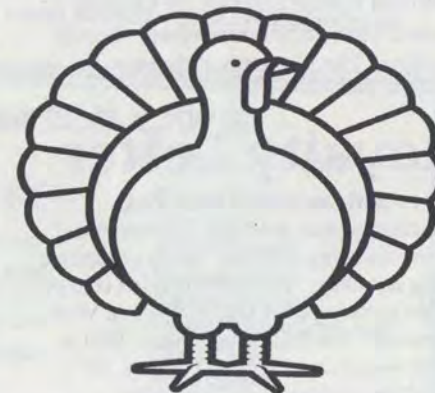
