#### NOMINATIONS FOR STATE OFFICES DUE MARCH 15

Our annual election of GSGRA officers takes place at the State Convention on May 3-4, and the nominations process is under way. Now is the time to start thinking about who you might want to see run for one of the Executive Board positions -- including yourself!

At the May election, we'll vote on the offices of GSGRA president, administrative vice president, vice president of rodeo operations, treasurer and secretary. Nominees must have joined GSGRA prior to May 3, 2002, and must have been a member in good standing for a minimum of one continuous year prior to the election date.





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
