

The documentary includes the rodeo action itself with participants from the Rocky Mountain Regional Rodeo (Denver, July 2003) and the Golden State Gay Rodeo in San Diego (September, 2003). A second part, the gay rodeo history and story, is still being filmed as the research and interviews require more time.

Our goal is to showcase the gay rodeo to many gay and straight audiences who know little, if anything, about the incredible experiences shared at the rodeos. A broadcast version (shorter) will be created for possible airing by a network such as Bravo. 
