#### Message from the Secretary By Mike Warren

This month I will be sending out a request for updated information. Five years is the national average that a person moves. For many of you, the clock started ticking a long time ago.

#### Horsh-U By Mike Warren

One of the things I noticed at the San Diego rodeo was the position some of the riders used for placing their feet in the stirrups. I several whose feet were pushed so far forward in their stirrups that it caused their legs to protrude outward to the sides like they were trying to stop a cow during shoot dogging. When in a canter or run,

their legs bounced around like they also caused a lack of foot control while riding.

stirrups for pleasure riding. These are meant for roping and cutting horse riders, and it is difficult to keep the foot in the proper position for pleasure riding using these types of stirrups. The depth of a deep stirrup makes it easy for a small foot to go through and get caught.

Use of oxbow stirrups requires boots with strong arch supports. They are meant for cutting, where riders place their feet all the way forward in the stirrup. This position is not desirable for pleasure riding.

As riders rode around the arena, I saw feet sliding through stirrups, feet flapping like flags in the wind as well as people losing their balance. Just image how embarrassing it would be to fall off when riding with your peers because your feet slipped through the stirrup.
