

HEARTLAND COWGIRL CAPTURES 2005 INTERNATIONAL RODEO CHAMPIONSHIP BUCKLE

Mesquite Texas: Bryn Geerdes from the Heartland Gay Rodeo Association won the 2005 IGRA Finals calf roping Championship, which is her 3rd roping title in the last 4 years. She is also the 2003 International chute dogging champion. Although HGRA sent a strong team of 6 past International champions, Geerdes was the only member to win a Finals title. "This is a great ending to a year where I didn't have a lot of success. The year started with a buckle in January, followed by 4 rodeos with no catches. I am thrilled with my performance." Her catch on Saturday was .87 seconds and 1.26 on Sunday.

In addition to Geerdes, HGRA members Teeny Copafellya, Rich Parker, Tim Kernan, Sam Kramer, and Brett Hartman also won ribbons. Here are the overall results:

Teeny – 7th chute dogging and 2nd in steer deco.

Sam - 8th barrel racing

Brett - 8th barrel racing

Rich - 8th steer deco

Tim – 4th chute dogging, 3rd flag racing, and 8th in steer deco

Team Heartland placed 7^{th} out of 19 teams. IGRA Finals 2006 will be held in Reno Nevada November $9^{th} - 12^{th}$
