RODEO RESULTS

The first rodeo of the 2006 IGRA rodeo series took lace in Phoenix (RRRR) this past weekend. Several HGRA members headed west and competed in the warm Arizona sunshine. Over 3500 spectators filled the new Rawhide Rodeo Venue and were treated to a great rodeo!

Our 2-Timers Char and Jo had a great rodeo and had very consistent times for all their events. Our other members Brett and Bryn, who competed in several events didn't do so well. The only thing that either brought home was Bryn, and that was a very bad cold!

RRRR had International media

coverage including press from France, Germany, the BBC from England, television coverage from E - TV, Entertainment Tonight, Access Hollywood, CBS, ABC, NBC, CNN, and Logo.

It is obvious that Brokeback Mountain has brought us a tremendous amount of media exposure. We are very hopeful that it will result in higher attendance at our rodeos and more new rodeo contestants. This is a very exciting time for IGRA and all their member associations.

Rodeo Events

Each month we will be featuring events that you will see at the Heartland Rodeo.

Our rodeo has events for everyone – you don't need a horse to participate. Two events that many newcomers to the rodeo will start with are - goat dressing and calf roping on foot. Have fun and see you on the rodeo circuit!

Goat Dressing

Goat dressing requires a team of 2. Western wear is not required for this event so you will often see competitors wearing athletic shoes and a baseball cap. The object of this event is to put a pair of jockey—style underwear on a goat. The team stands 50 feet from the point where the goat is tethered. One of the team members has a pair of jockey-style. When the whistle sounds, the team runs to the goat and attempts to dress the

goat with the underwear. The team member without the underwear picks up the goat's rear hooves, grabs the underwear from around the other member's arms, and pulls it up the legs of the goat. Both team members must then race back to the start/finish line and cross the finish line to stop the time. The underwear must stay over the goat's tail bone until the timer is tagged by both members.

The payoff in this event is usually the highest since so many contestants compete in it.

The times average anywhere between 10.5 and 12 seconds.



CALF ROPING ON FOOT

Anyone who has a rope and a trash can or tree stump can practice this event. Most of these ropers never throw at a calf until the actual event. Your practice time is spent throwing at non moving objects. I know of one contestant that learned to rope in a parking lot throwing at parking pylons. During the event, the contestant stands in the roping box. When they call for the calf to be released, they attempt to throw a loop over the calf's head. Once the loop passes the head, the contestant must pull the slack in the rope. To avoid rope burn-LET GO! This is another event where the payoff is very good.
