Rodeo Events

This month we are featuring 2 more events that you will see at the Heartland Rodeo. As you can see our rodeo has events for everyone – you don't need a horse to participate. Two more events that many newcomers on the rodeo can start with are – steer deco and chute dogging. Have fun and hope to see you on the rodeo circuit!

Steer Deco ~ Camp Event

Steer Deco requires a team of 2. Western wear is not required for this event so you will often see competitors wearing athletic shoes and a baseball cap. The object of this event is to tie a ribbon on the tail of a steer. One member of the team stands 10 feet from the chute gate holding the end of a 25 foot rope, which is looped around the steer's horns. The other team member stands 40 feet from the chute and has a 24-inch long ribbon. When the chute opens, the team must bring the steer out and across the 10-foot line. The member with the ribbon tries to tie the ribbon on the steer's tail while the other team member tries to remove the rope from the steer's horns. When the ribbon is on the tail and the loop is off the horns, the ribbon-tier must tag the timer back at the chute area. This event is pictured below in picture on left. The payoff in this event is usually high since so many contestants compete in it. The times average anywhere between 7.0 and 10 seconds.







Chute Dogging ~ Rough Stock Event

This event is designed to give even the novice a chance to compete in rough stock events. The steer and the contestant both start in the bucking chute and face a 60 second time limit. When the chute gate opens, the contestant must bring the steer out and cross the 10-foot line in front of the chute, and then attempt to wrestle or "dog" the steer to the ground. The contestant will turn the steer's head up and towards the steer's shoulder, hoping the steer will fall over on it's other shoulder, causing all 4 feet to face the same direction as the head is turned. In this event, either the dogger "dogs" or gets "dogged" ... sound easy? These animals weigh approximately 500 lbs. HGRA has produced 7 International champions in this event. From 2000 – 2004, Heartland cowgirls captured 5 Final's buckles and the cowboy's have captured 2.

It is a good idea to have a mouth guard and flack jacket when you start competing. Jackets can be borrowed from another competitor. Cowboy hat, boots, long sleeve shirt and jeans are required. This event is pictured above in the 2nd and 3rd picture.

HGRA Membership


