2005 CONVENTION RESULTS Lorry King -Trustee

Sunday, July 31 was a long day for many NGRA members, as we met at the Center for our Annual Meeting. This was our chance to make desired changes in the Bylaws and Standing Rules, and changes we made!

Some changes were relatively minor, such as adding educational language to enhance our chances of gaining 501(c)3 charitable organization status with the Internal Revenue Service, clarifying that Bylaws and Standing Rule changes can be sent by email or postal mail, and requiring the rodeo budget to be presented monthly.

However, some were greater changes, such as allowing the Treasurer to sign checks (along with a second board signature), adding Royalty and Committee Chairs to the disciplinary section, and separating Bylaws from Standing Rules. Standing Rules can now be changed at a General Membership Meeting when prior notice is

given, instead of only once a year as in the past. Currently, the only subject covered in the Standing Rules is Royalty.

The Standing Rules that were changed include requiring all Royalty contestants to attain a score that is at least 75% of the total possible points in order to win a title, denying any titleholder whose title is removed from ever competing again in an NGRA Pageant, and deleting the horsemanship requirement from the pageant.

All members will receive a copy of the amended Bylaws and Standing Rules within 60 days, either by email notice once they are posted on the website or by postal mail, and the changes become effective immediately. If you have any questions, please contact any board member.

Thanks to all members who attended and gave their energy, ideas and experience to the results.






