Please meet us at the staging area on 4th and Charleston by 7:00 PM.

Then plan to stop by the NGRA area at the Pride Festival on Saturday, May 13. This year's Festival is located at the Government Center downtown (the complex with the pyramid). NGRA will have an entire area with one booth featuring information about NGRA and BigHorn Rodeo, including video of the rodeo. Just across the aisle, get relief from the hot sun by mounting the NGRA saddle and getting sunscreen rubbed on your back by a real cowboy or cowgirl. The NGRA jail will be open for business and this year we're adding a special activity area for kids. It was a wonderful event, and the Florida members put on an impressive show. Only one of our contestants was able to travel all the way across the country to compete, and as usual, didn't come home empty handed.

Robert Salcedo won a First both days in Bareback Bronc Riding and so brought home the Buckle! He also placed 2nd in Chute Dogging on Saturday and 5th in Wild Drag on Sunday.

Congratulations to Robert for winning one of the first buckles ever awarded in Florida!

Since San Diego is so close, we had four NGRA Team Members compete – Richard Armstrong, Chris Due, Lee Hale and Robert Salcedo.

Richard took a 6th in Poles on Saturday and a 4th on Sunday, for a 3rd overall. He placed 4th in Barrels on Saturday and 1st on Sunday, for a 2nd overall. Then in Flags he earned a 1st on Saturday and a 2nd on Sunday and

brought home the Buckle! Because of this impressive performance in the speed events, Richard earned the added prize money for All Around Speed Champion! He also earned a 4th in Calf Roping on Sunday. All these points helped him to 3rd runner up to All Around Cowboy. Richard and Chris teamed up to take 3rd place in Steer Deco on Sunday. Chris was a competitor in Calf Roping on Foot, but his roping skills aren't quite in place yet, as on Saturday he roped the calf all right, unfortunately, it was just around the nose! Next time, let's try for the whole head, Chris, OK?

Sunday was Robert's day, as he took 6th place in Chute Dogging, 5th place in Goats, and 5th place in Wild Drag. Robert competed in the horse-back roping events for the first time and I'm sure we'll see him winning ribbons in these events soon. Lee has been off the circuit for a while, but I'm sure he'll be back to winning soon as well.

These four great Cowboys earned enough points to rank NGRA 5th out of 10 Associations entered. May brings us rodeos in St. Louis, Omaha and Oklahoma City. Good luck to Team NGRA!
