August is gone and a very busy fall calendar is upon us. I'd like to thank Randy Meadows (aka Kandice Kane) for representing NGRA as alternate Trustee in New Mexico for the Zia Regional Rodeo. Randy reports they had a great rodeo with 58 contestants. Randy and J from New Orleans competed in "Community Goat Dressing" and got 8th place! Sorry I missed that!

I just returned from Chicago where in addition to attending the rodeo I also attended the IGRA Executive Board meeting, IGRA Board meeting, Ethical Practices Review Board meeting and a Trustee's meeting. Finally as if that weren't enough meetings, I also attended the IGRA Gay World Rodeo Finals committee meeting. Finals is shaping up very well and all of NGRA's duties are covered.

NGRA was well represented by myself as Trustee, Lorry King as Assistant Secretary and our very own MR. NGRA, Michael Judkins. Michael competed for the first time and took home his first rodeo award ribbons. He placed 5th on Saturday, 4th on Sunday, and 3rd overall in Goat Dressing.

The Windy City rodeo was a huge success! They had good weather for a change and drew big crowds on both days. The rodeo was held at a beautiful private venue and everything ran smoothly and drama-free. Unfortunately, contestant Wade Earp broke his arm riding a brutal Bronc on Sunday. If you are planning on attending the Gay World Rodeo Finals in Denver October 1-12 and would like to volunteer, please let me know. We have open spots for ticket sales, security and arena crew volunteers. Also, you can purchase tickets online now by visiting www.igra.com.

Also, this is the last chance to sign-up as a delegate or alternate for the annual IGRA Convention in New Orleans October 30 - November 2. NGRA will pay your registration fee and you are eligible to request a \$100 travel stipend if you attend the committee meetings on Friday and the convention sessions on Saturday and Sunday. This is where IGRA associations meet and consider changes to Bylaws and Rodeo Rules. The many standing and ad hoc committees of IGRA meet and recommend proposals which are considered by the entire assembly on Saturday and Sunday. Attending IGRA convention in New Orleans on Halloween weekend is sure to be a trip you'll never forget. Please contact me no later than October 1 if you'd like to attend IGRA Convention with our delegation.

2008 NGRA ByLaws and Standing Rule changes.

BY LAWS

- **1. Article I, Section II, E**. -- Allows members to receive compensation under certain circumstances.
- **2. Article V, Section I, G**. -- The immediate past President will have a vote on the BOD for one year.
- **3. Article VI, Section I, A.** -- All elected officers, except the Trustee, are required to attend a minimum of 8 BOD and 6 GMM meetings per year, as well as the NGRA Convention. Board members not meeting the requirements are subject to discipline.
- **4.Article VI,Section I, B.** -- Newly elected Board members must be present at the 1st BOD meeting following May 1 and outgoing Board members must have their records in order and hand them over at that time.
- **5. Article VI, Section I, C.** -- All officers shall prepare a monthly written report to the Secretary 6 days prior to the BOD meeting.
- **6. Article VI, Section II, H**. -- The President shall appoint duties to the Members at Large.
- **7. Article VI, Section III, E.** -- All duties relating to Membership shall be the responsibility of the VP.
- **8. Article VI, Section V, G**. -- The Treasurer shall provide a current month's bank reconciliation at all BOD meetings.
- **9. Article VI, Section V, I.** -- The Treasurer shall provide an annual budget at the June BOD.
- **10. Article VII, Section VIII, A.** -- The Rodeo Director may be removed by a 2/3 vote of the BOD.
- **11. Article VIII, Section II,** G. -- Final rodeo financial report will be submitted to the BOD no later than 60 days after the completion of the rodeo.
- **12. Article VIII, Section II, H.** -- The Rodeo Director will report in writing to the BOD.
- **13. Article XI, Section III** -- NGRA logos are included as part of the Bylaws.

STANDING RULES

Section 1 -- All entrants must be a member of NGRA a minimum of 90 days.

Section 2 -- An individual who currently holds a Royalty or title from another organization will not be eligible to enter the competition, nor is any current NGRA titleholder eligible to compete or hold a title from another organization.


Section 3 -- Application and entry fee must be submitted at least 90 days prior

Section 5 -- At least one but no more than 2 judges in each category shall be a current member of the BOD.

Section 12, B. -- All contestants will be required to host a minimum of one fundraising event for a 501(c)(3) approved by the BOD. Also, all contestants must attend, in the past 6 months of membership, a minimum of 3 GMMs and 2 BOD meetings.

- Section 12, E. -- Must provide a Plan of Action to the Trustee.
- Section 18, E. -- Must attend a minimum of 1 non NGRA rodeos.
- **Section 23** -- In the case of a royalty produced fundraiser that is required to compete at IGRA, funds will be funneled through NGRA provided that the event is revenue neutral to NGRA.
