Howdy, Y'all, and thanks for all your support so far this year as we raise funds to support LUCKY 13 – BigHorn Rodeo 2009.

The Rodeo Planning Committee has been very active since I was appointed as Rodeo Director in December. My thanks to all of them!

For this month's update, here's a list of all the things we've done:

- 1. Selected rodeo beneficiary This year, the rodeo beneficiary will be FOCUS. FOCUS Finding Our Clients Useful Solutions is a program of the Winged Dragon Society. They are providing services to people with HIV and AIDS in our community.
- 2. Selected host hotel Our host hotel this year is the Eastside Cannery. We encourage all of you to make it a "staycation" and come on down to the Cannery for rodeo weekend. The rates of \$29.95 per night (Sunday-Thursday) and \$69.96 per night (Friday-Saturday) can't be beat!
- 3. Decided to have a night rodeo For the first time in NGRA history, our rodeo will be a 1-go, night rodeo. For all the details about how this will work, visit the website at www.bighornrodeo.com. Contestant registration and meet-and-greet will be Friday night, starting at 6:13 p.m. Saturday, the morning performances will start at 8:13 a.m. The opening ceremonies for the evening show will start at 5:13 p.m. Several events will be split between the two sets of performances; our most popular events will all be held at night. We hope the community will come out and support this first-ever effort!
- 4. All of our committee chairs have been working hard. Grand Entry promises to be very exciting; our party coordinator is planning parties on Friday afternoon and on Sunday afternoon (Sunday's party will be hosted by The Blue Moon); our entertainment coordinator is working to create an exciting weekend; our vendor coordinator is already lining up lots of exciting vendors; and, our volunteer coordinator is soon to have volunteer needs for the event!

We encourage everyone to come out and support BigHorn Rodeo 2009. We have fundraisers for the rodeo every 2nd Saturday at Charlie's and every 4th Saturday at Badlands. We also sell hot dogs at Charlie's every Sunday. The bus trip coming up on June 20 is always a big revenue generator for us.

TRUSTEE REPORT

The Las Vegas PRIDE parade and festival were huge successes again this year and I'd like to thank all of the parade participants and the NGRA volunteers who did such a great job running the gate. JD Jensen did a great job coordinating our team of 24 individuals who put in 144.5 volunteer hours for NGRA and raising over \$1,400 for BigHorn Rodeo. Just over 10,000 people attended the festival this year and a good time was had by all.

Lorry King attended the IGRA Board meetings as my alternate and there were several important developments of interest to NGRA:

- 2010 IGRA University was approved for Las Vegas
- The 2010 World Gay Rodeo Finals were approved for Laughlin, hosted by NGRA. The AVI Resort and Casino will be the host hotel and the Mojave Crossing Events Center will host the rodeo.
- NGRA received a variance approved for BigHorn Rodeo 2009 allowing us to modify the random draw process due to our split event format for 2009.
- IGRA Convention Update: Toronto Nov. 12-15, 2009: Costs will be converted from Canadian Delegate costs is \$80 will be \$64 US with conversion; Hotel will be \$115 or \$95 US. Please notify a board member if you are interested in representing NGRA at the IGRA Convention in Toronto.
- World Gay Rodeo Finals ticketing and marketing was assigned to NGRA. Hotel rooms in Albuquerque will be \$85; Finals entertainment to include the Dolly Parton look alike & Demented Divas
- IGRA Royalty has raised \$2,800 and have covered all rodeo's so far and would appreciate having help with accommodations when they travel and would also like to have a goal provided in advance for any groups wanting fundraising assistance from the IGRA Royalty Team.
- The IGRA archives have been donated to the Gene Autry museum in LA who will curate the archive for exhibition, scholarship and possible fundraising opportunities. Founding IGRA member and owner of Charlie's, John King has been appointed to Chair the Gay Rodeo Legacy Project and will work in tandem with the archives.

Now that Memorial Day has come and gone, it's time to really start focusing on our Lucky 13 BigHorn Rodeo. Your Rodeo Planning Committee is doing a great job planning our first night rodeo.
