2009 NGRA Convention Results

On the afternoon of June 28, 2009, 15 members met at the Center and held NGRA's 2009 Annual Meeting and Convention. The discussion was lively and passionate, but always civil and friendly. We were happy to have as a special guest one of our out-of-town members, Benjamin Avant, who is IGRA's Parliamentarian and took on that same role for us. Some of the more important proposals that passed are:

- 1. We now have a new membership category -- the Contestant Member -- designed for those people who sign up for membership at our rodeo solely to compete there, with no desire to participate in the organization's meetings and events. This category is also for dancers who want to compete at the IGRA competition as a partner to one of our members, but does not want to participate fully in the organization.
- 2. The Treasurer annual budget will now be prepared and presented to the Board of Directors each December instead of June.
- 3. A quorum will now require the lessor of 1/10th or 10 members in good standing, instead of 1/10 of all members.
- 4. The Immediate Past President will no longer have a vote of the board of directors.
- 5. A candidate for the Board of Directors must be a member of NGRA for at least 180 days instead of 90.
- 6. A candidate for royalty must be at least 21 years old instead of 18.
- 7. In the Spirit section of the royalty competition, a candidate will be judged on their contributions to both the community and to NGRA instead of contributions in either area.
- 8. No 1st place title holder will be able to compete in the same category for more than two consecutive years.
- 9. The number of judges at the royalty competition may now vary by category and may be members of NGRA, not limited to the Board of Directors.
- 10. The Member of the Year ballot may now be sent via electronic mail and may be posted online.

The new NGRA bylaws will be available in the member section of the website at www.ngra.com later this month.
