The dog days of summer have arrived and we are approaching the end of the IGRA rodeo season.

NGRA is also involved in the local rodeo community by co-producing the Summer 4-D Barrel Race Buckle Series at Horseman's Park. 
Be it in your dollars spent, help behind the scenes, supplying us with a raffle item. Ahead of time let me just say a big THANK YOU for your help!!!!!!!
