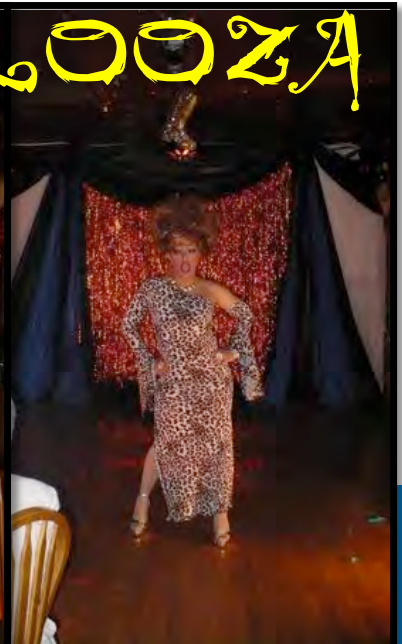

I hope to see many of you down in Phoenix during their rodeo weekend, which is conveniently being held over the President's Day holiday, February 18<sup>th</sup> through the 21<sup>st</sup>. ## IGRA Board Meeting Highlights—St. Louis, Missouri—January 14, 2011

### IGRA President, Doug Graff Reported:

- Trustees and Certified Officials will now be the official contestant liaisons.
- Subsidies from IGRA will stop effective 2012 for IGRA University, Royalty Competition and Dance Competitions.
- Opportunities: IGRA website, NYC Trade Show, Gay Days in Orlando, corporate Bud Light sponsorship, IGRA Convention to be "owned" by IGRA, and better utilization of the online store. The online store will allow the purchase of IGRA merchandise, rule book requests and registration for IGRA Convention and University.
- President's priorities include: consolidation of association memberships, which will allow associations to setup memberships and renewals on the IGRA store site; Rodeo Resources will be moved within IGRA University; chairperson selection for IGRA Hall of Fame and Women's Outreach Committees and selection of an IGRA Media Spokesperson by the next board meeting in Ft. Lauderdale. Resumes will be accepted through February for any one interested in the IGRA Media Spokesperson position. In the interim, Doug Graff will handle these duties while the job description is better defined and a candidate is selected.
- Automatic shipments of rodeo rule books will stop effective this year. Until now, rule books were being mailed to all contestants who competed in the last two years. Going forward, contestants will have to request rule books from the IGRA website to have one mailed to them. There will be additional rule books available at the Phoenix rodeo in February to help us through the adjustment period while contestants become familiar with the new process. Associations will still be mailed 10 rule books at the beginning of the year and more right before their rodeo. Officials will continue to receive rule books and CDs as they have in the past.

### Other Info:

Ed Barry was appointed as corporate auditor as he is a CPA and has an extensive financial background.

### IGRA Vice President, Andrew Goodman Reported:

- The fundraising goals for the IGRA royalty team are being increased to be more in-line with the new budget, which excludes \$5K in funding for the royalty competition in 2012. The new goals for the team are \$12,200 for IGRA and \$2,800 for charity, totaling \$15K.
- One of the main goals of the IGRA royalty team this year is to focus on community outreach, which includes increasing membership, getting new contestants on-board for the royalty program, rodeos and the dance competition.

### IGRA Administrative Assistant, Tommy Channel Reported:

- The WGRF committee would like to be given a one-page ad in each rodeo program when possible.
- The IGRA liability insurance policy was discussed and each association will be billed based on whether they are having a rodeo, rodeo school or neither. The cost is about \$420 for associations hosting a rodeo, about \$210 for those not hosting a rodeo and about \$110 for a stand-alone rodeo school. Rodeo schools held during the same rodeo weekend will be insured under the rodeo policy. The additional insured forms are available on the IGRA website.

### IGRA University Bids for 2012 and 2013:

- Bids were accepted from GWGRA, NGRA, and SGRA. GWGRA won the bid for both years and IGRA-U will be held in St. Louis the next two years.

### Trustee Meeting Highlights

- ARGRA was granted a variance to buck heifers instead of junior bulls.
- The finals committee was granted a variance for their arena size of 100 x 200, where 120 x 195 is required. The finals committee was also granted a variance for their date change to Oct 7-9, 2011.
- The Rodeo Review Process was discussed. When >1/3 of the trustees are present, the Rodeo Review Committee will consist of the Division Chairs and the Rodeo Review Trustee; when ≤1/3 are present, it will consist of all trustees who are present.
- The rodeo checklist was revised and accepted.
