NGRA ANNUAL CONVENTION By Brian Rogers

The NGRA annual convention took place on Saturday, June 25 at The Center. Lunch and doughnuts (thanks Guy) were served and the members present participated in lively debate of a range of topics.

A summary of changes adopted:

- No individual may be a member of the Royalty team and serve as President or Vice President at the same time without prior approval of the current board of directors.
- Language was added to Article X on Meetings specifically authorizing combined Board and Membership meetings. The language spells out that distinct blocks of time will be provided for the exercise of the rights and responsibilities of the both the Board of Directors and the General Membership. In matters where approval is needed by the Board of Directors followed by ratification by the General Membership, two votes will be required.
- Corrections and additions were crafted to Article XI which covers Corporate Name, Logos And Intellectual Property
- Clarification was made regarding the requirement for Royalty titleholders to attend
 BigHorn Rodeo in sash and attend NGRA Convention if physically and financially able.
- Enforcement language was added to the residency requirement for NGRA Royalty title holders.
- Language was added encouraging first NGRA Royalty runners-up to run for the IGRA Royalty competition. This mirrors changes made at the last IGRA convention.
- Language was clarified addressing Royalty contestants and titleholders which defines what titles are considered in conflict with duties as NGRA Royalty.
- Current Bylaws require board candidates to be an active member for 180 days. New language was added creating a 90 day requirement for Members at Large.

As chair, I'd like to thank all the members who attended and participated. Discussion and debate was conducted in a thoughtful and respectful manner and we were able to conduct the business of the organization professionally and in a timely manner.

The board voted to nominate Pendleton Whiskey and Equine Event Management, LLC for IGRA Appreciation Awards and to nominate Patrick Terry for an IGRA International Award, and approved the purchase of a half-page ad in the Las Vegas Pride Guide.

The NGRA membership voted for Ken Wells and David Blunk for Members-of-the-Month for May, 2011 and nominated Pam Kazmarek, Brenda Ben, Justin Liming, and Michael Charleboix for honorary memberships. The membership will vote on these nominations at the July meeting.


