GO RAISE CASH 1993 – 2011

On November 6th, the IGRA circuit lost one of its greatest equine competitors. Go Raise Cash, aka Cash, owned and loved by long time NGRA member and contestant Richard Armstrong, was humanly euthanized due to complications from colic. In the many years that Richard competed on the powerhouse barrel horse, Cash won numerous buckles at several different IGRA Rodeos on the IGRA Circuit, including many invitations to IGRA Finals. Cash was semi-retired in 2008 but came out of retirement to compete with another NGRA Member, Chris Due, in the 2011 rodeo season. After only running at the RRRR in Arizona, Cash was able to qualify for IGRA Finals one last time. Cash will be greatly missed by Richard and Chris as well as many on the IGRA Rodeo Circuit who had come to know and love him over his many years of competition.

The Importance of Royalty

Recently Melissa Lawrence, Miss NGRA 2006, reminded me of something I said when I first became involved in NGRA. I didn't understand the role of rodeo royalty in our organization. Since 2006, my understanding has grown by leaps and bounds. Now, I can't really imagine how our rodeo association would survive without royalty.

In NGRA and IGRA, the royalty work very, very hard to raise money for our charity partners and for our associations.

For BigHorn Rodeo 14, the royalty teams from 2010 and 2011 raised nearly \$12,000. The 2011 team has continued to raise money (for BigHorn Rodeo 15) since May. (The teams also raised money for the association; the money is split between the association and the rodeo.) NGRA was able to donate \$10,000 to our charity partner for BigHorn Rodeo 14. Without the fundraising efforts of our royalty, that might not have been possible.
