Gay and Lesbian Rodeo Heritage Foundation Announces First Paladin Award Dinner

It is time to dust off your best cowboy and cowgirl duds and attend the 2012 Paladin Award Dinner to support the Gay and Lesbian Rodeo Heritage Foundation™.

This dress up western award dinner will honor one individual or group with the first ever "Paladin" Award. The Paladin term has long been used to recognize the "hero of a cause" and in this case it has a western heritage theme. The winner of the recognition is a closely guarded secret and will be announced at the dinner event, following a presentation of "Pride in the Saddle", the history of gay rodeo in Nevada.

The Gay & Lesbian Rodeo Heritage Foundation™ (GLRHF) was established in 2009 and has federal 501(c)3 status. A portion of your ticket to the dinner is tax deductible. As a charitable organization, the Mission of the GLRHF is to serve the broader community by preserving, maintaining, promoting and communicating the role of Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual and Transgender individuals in the sport of rodeo and the western lifestyle.

This Mission is achieved through private donations, application for grants and hosting educational and cultural events. Funds raised will be used to support projects designed to document and preserve relevant historical events, rodeo training schools, scholarships, lectures, workshops and rodeos, with an emphasis on outreach to the younger rural GLBTQ community.

The Paladin Award is given annually. This year has significance as the inaugural award presentation. The event is happening Sunday November 12, 2012 at 6:30 pm at the Tuscany Hotel in Las Vegas, immediately following the 2012 International Gay Rodeo Association Convention. Individual tickets are \$100.00 and a group rate is available.



I flew into San Francisco to meet up with John Paul Soto for the last rodeo before finals. We would be joined later by Miss IGRA 2012 Victoria Weston. This by far was the best drag friendly weather Victoria and I had. I was in face each day for about 18 hours each day. As it turned out a community goat dressing event took place right after goat dressing. John Paul partnered up with Victoria and I partnered up with Miss BAC 2012 Tiger Lily. I congratulate John Paul and Victoria for winning the community goat dressing buckle. Had Tiger Lily not tripped on the way back to the finish line the buckle would be ours. I must say as everyone pointed out at least the wig stayed on. Later that night we helped with awards and called it wrap for the rodeo weekend, as I had an 8 am flight back to Vegas.

He has been involved with the Nevada Gay Rodeo Association since 2007 - holding both Member at Large and Board Director positions. He was the Vendor Chair for BigHorn Rodeo 15. In February of 2011, Brian was named Mr, Charlie's for that month. Brian has helped raise money volunteering his time, not only at Rodeo and Mr. Charlie's, but has assisted at SNAPI and AFAN Events.
