


Storage Work Day

NGRA Elections

Election time is quickly approaching and NGRA needs you! If you have never held a board position with NGRA, this is a great time to consider putting your name in the hat to have a chance to make a difference and play an active part in the decision-making process! Ballots will be going out immediately after the March General Membership Meeting where nominations will officially close. All positions, except Trustee, are up for election. There are four Executive Board positions: President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer in addition to four Director positions (formerly Members-at-Large). The terms for President and Treasurer are two years, and all others up for election are one year. To be eligible to run for the executive board, you must have been a member for at least 180 days; to run for a Director position, you must have been a member for 90 days.
