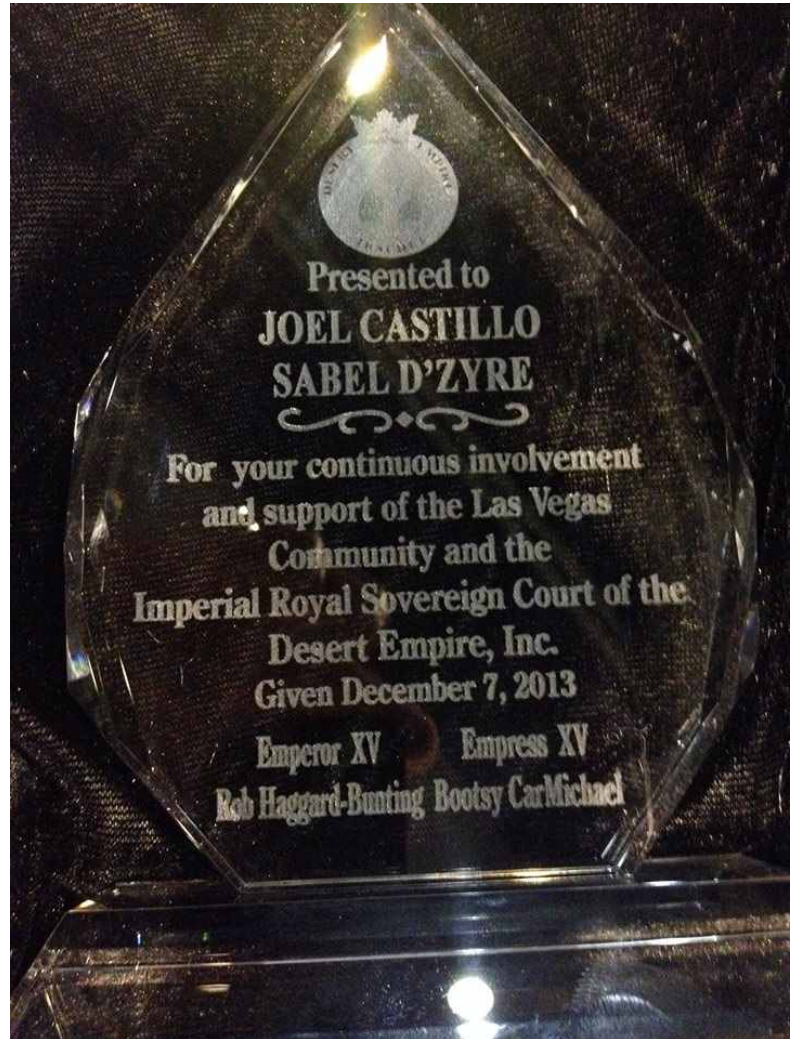

### How We Judge Others Is How We Judge Ourselves

What an honor it was to attend the IGRA Convention in San Diego this year as a delegate.

I learned many things during my visit. The first--never disappear without telling someone where you are going. The second--to be more respectful of others. Our members are extremely important to us—ALL OF THEM. We are a Team. There is no / in team.

According to a report provided during the IGRA Convention, our overall membership has decreased. We need to look at the reasons why and make changes fast! One of those reasons, I believe, is our attitude towards others.

## From Your Volunteer Coordinator

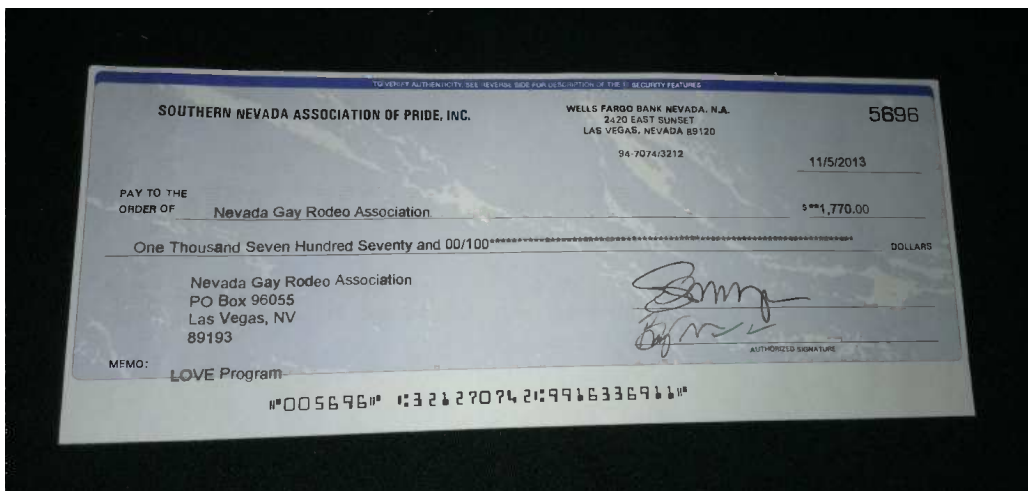
In the October newsletter I thanked all those who manned the ticket booth and the front entrance at Pride for their hard work.

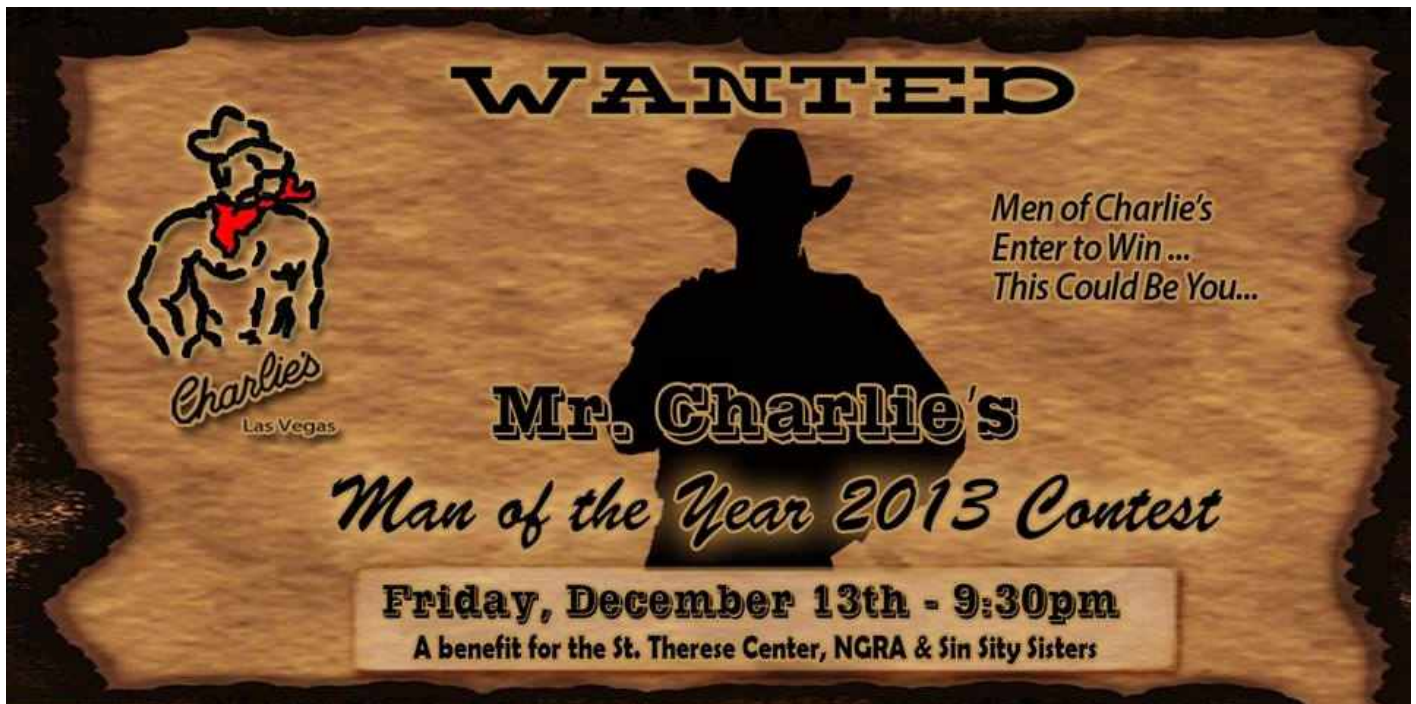
