
## NGRA 2016 Board Election

Election time is quickly approaching and NGRA needs you! If you have never held a board position with NGRA, this is a great time to consider putting your name in the hat to have a chance to make a difference and play an active part in the decision-making process!

Ballots will be going out immediately after the November Board and General Membership Meeting on Monday November 16th where nominations will officially close. All positions except Trustee are up for election. There are two executive board positions: President and Secretary, in addition to two Director positions. The terms for President and Secretary are two years, and the Directors are one year. To be eligible to run for the executive board, you must have been a member for at least 180 days; to run for a Director position, you must have been a member for 90 days. If you are interested in or considering running for the board, please contact our Election Coordinator and Trustee, Guy Puglisi at <u>trustee@ngra.com</u> as soon as possible.

Those running for election will need to provide a brief biography with a little personal and/or professional background including any accomplishments or qualifications they wish to share with our membership. If you have any questions about the duties, you can find this information in the NGRA Bylaws which are available on the NGRA website at <u>www.ngra.com</u>, or feel free to contact Guy or any other current board member.

Members who have provided an email address will receive their ballots via email using Survey Monkey. In the event we do not have an email address on file, a ballot will be mailed to you.

### Pride Float Construction Tuesday, September 15<sup>th</sup> to Friday, September 18<sup>th</sup>






#### Finally a chance to sit down.


