Trustee Elections

Hello, I am Ken Wells, I have been appointed by the NGRA Board of Directors as Election Coordinator for the Trustee Elections.

What is a Trustee, you ask? Good question. The Trustee for NGRA, serves as a liaison for NGRA at IGRA (International Gay Rodeo Association) level. Also acts as a Compliance Officer with IGRA.

Extract from the IGRA BYLAWS: Article IX

Section 3. Election of Trustees.

Paragraph A. Each Trustee shall serve a term of three (3) years except that upon admission to IGRA, a lesser term of office may be determined to coincide with the expiration of office of other Trustees to maintain a balance of incoming and outgoing Trustees. The existing Trustees shall make the determination of a partial term at the time of admission.

Paragraph B. Each Trustee elected to office shall serve for the period specified or until the election and qualification of his/her successor to such office.

Paragraph C. An alternate Trustee may be designated to serve in the place of a Trustee at any IGRA meeting, rodeo, convention, or other official IGRA function, with the exception of Ethical Practices Review Board (EPRB) meetings. Such designation must be submitted in writing by either the Association Trustee or President, and shall include the duration of the designation, and shall continue in effect until expiration or rescinded in writing by the Association Trustee or President, regardless of the presence of the Association Trustee at the function.

Section 4. Trustees.

Each Trustee may be requested by the President or the board to serve as liaison to the Board of Directors in one of the following areas:

- 1. IGRA Standing Committee.
- 2. IGRA Special Committee.

Section 5. Limitation.

Paragraph A. Term of Office.

- 1. The term of office shall be three (3) years. Election shall be by the respective Member Association in accordance with its bylaws or rules.
- 2. All Trustees shall assume office on January 1.

Role of the Public Relations Spokesperson


The Public Relations Spokesperson shall:





Trustee's News

President Bruce Gros

LSGRA decided not to renew its membership with IGRA so it can focus on building its association locally without the financial obligations IGRA membership requires.

While associations begin looking at changes to make at IGRA Convention this year, Bruce would also like us to look at ways to improve our association, our rodeos, and participation.

Vice President Jason Bernard

All members of the IGRA Royalty Team have met their minimum fundraising requirements.

Secretary Ron Trusley

Nominations for the International and Trustees awards were received and ballots will be distributed.

WGRF Committee

Room nights are about 120 less than this time last year, which is a concern. People are encouraged to book early as they can always be canceled later if necessary.

Sponsorship is currently \$37,000, which is close to last year's total.

Robert Thurtell expressed concern that there was minimal trustee presence at WGRF last year. Also, he emphasized that this is ALL of our finals and we should become stakeholders at the individual and association levels.

The Committee recommended Horseman's Park for WGRF 2017 but Board rejected their recommendation. The Committee brought back a second site of Albuquerque, which was approved by the BOD.

Miscellaneous

September 19th is the 60-day deadline for Convention proposals.

The Smithsonian has expressed interest in placing the most significant items from the IGRA archives and the history of gay rodeo.

John Hill would like associations to share event information, etc. to cgrajohn@gmail.com and he will share the information on the IGRA social media platforms.

The 2017 IGRA BOD meetings will be held in January, April, August, and at IGRA Convention in Las Vegas, Little Rock, Santa Fe, and wherever Convention is held, respectively.

Associations are strongly encouraged to present proposals at the 2016 IGRA Convention for the location in 2018. DSRA is prepared to present a bid, which appears very financially viable.

The 2018 IGRA University will be held in OKC at the Habana Complex.

NMGRA is experimenting with a new format to include partial performances on Friday and Saturday nights in addition to Saturday and Sunday during the day. For more information, visit their website.




