Pride Parade Float



He helped run his parents lodge and motel. He and his mom owned and operated a restaurant. Bob was a certified EMT/Paramedic for Montana before moving to Salt Lake City to continue in emergency medicine. He was also certified as a EMT/Paramedic in Utah.

Randy Larsen grew up in Vernal and Salt Lake City, Utah. He is the youngest of nine children. His chosen profession was computer programming. He has been with the same company in Las Vegas for 28 years. His other interests are photography and music.

Bob and Randy met in 1979 in a popular bar where Bob bartended part-time. They have been together ever since. They moved to Las Vegas in 1989 where Randy continued employment as a programmer, and Bob was an accountant in the homebuilding industry.

The popularity of "New Country" music and rodeo (both straight and gay) were a big part of their lives. They attended many of the IGRA rodeos around the country. It was the rodeo in Phoenix in 1992, when on the way to the rodeo they stopped into Charlie's for a quick screwdriver cocktail. Bob made the comment, "You know, we can do this in Vegas!" The rest is 25 years of wonderful history. A new generation of cowboys and cowgirls keep the dream alive.






From Your Volunteer Coordinator




